

What an exciting line! The magic that lies within the imagination of a child, where, with the blink on an eye, they whisk themselves away to a far-away land of pirates, Indians, and mermaids.

Just think what it would be like to jump up on the wings of the wind and fly!

That's just what Wendy, Michael and John do. Of course they get a little help from Peter Pan and a healthy dose of fairy dust.

Peter Pan was first introduced by J. M. Barrie in 1901 in the short story *Peter Pan*, or *The Boy Who Wouldn't Grow Up*. A stage version was introduced in 1904 and has since been flying in theatres, capturing the imaginations and hearts of audiences worldwide. The play's initial popularity spawned a book which was basically excerpts from the script – *Peter Pan in Kensington Gardens* – released in 1906. J. M. Barrie expanded the work into a novel in 1911 entitled *Peter and Wendy*.

The high-flying fantasy, *Peter Pan, the Musical*, will delight children of all ages, when the boy who will

never grow up swoops down onto the James York Playhouse stage July 18 through July 27. Grand adventures await you on your journey to J. M. Barrie's Neverland, which if you need directions to get there, is "second star to the right, and straight on 'til morning!"

Director Peter Natale, (A Chorus Line, 42nd Street, George M!, The Producers, Curtains, Chicago, Annie), says this production enthusiastically embraces the magic of childhood. The boy who never grew up is the child in all of us who is youth, joy, and freedom. Childhood magic is revealed through the contrast between a world dominated by time (the London nursery), and Neverland, a timeless place where one can never grow old. The other childhood magic of course is the amazement of flight. Our production will be assisted by Flying by Foy to bring all the magic of Peter Pan to life!

Many of our patrons find the temperature level of the theater a f f e c t s t h e m differently - what one person finds to be too cool another person finds to be too warm. We



all experience the theater temperature differently. We have the theater set at 74 degrees. If you find this to be too cool, please bring a sweater or light jacket. We are continually working to make your theater experience more enjoyable.

Recent modifications now allow us to turn the blower speed down while still keeping the theater and lobby at a comfortable temperature. With this newest change, you should no longer feel the cool air or the heat blowing directly on you and the noise level of the blowers should be considerably quieter, resulting in a more enjoyable theatre experience.


